squadra	A group of players who play together to win a game
tifoso	A fan is a person who loves their football team and supports it during the matches
stadio	A stadium is a big place where people go to watch football games or other events
campione	A sports champion is a person who wins games or competitions because they are very good at their sport
gol	In football a goal is when the ball goes into the net and your team scores a point
tradizione	The tradition of Italian football is everything people have done for a long time in football, like cheering for their team, singing songs, and playing exciting matches
nazionale	The national football team is the team that represents a country in matches against other countries
passione	Passion in football is when you love the game or your team a lot and feel excited during the matches
bandiere	A flag is a piece of colored cloth that represents a team or a country. In football, fans in the stadium often wave the flags to show their support for the team.
striscioni	A banner is a long piece of cloth or similar material with writings or drawings. Fans in the stadium use it to encourage the team or show special messages.

mondiale	The World Cup is a competition with teams from many countries around the world
palla	The ball is a round object. It is used for playing
derby	A derby is a game between two teams from the same city or area
porta	The goal is the place where you try to score in soccer
