TÉRMINO	DEFINICIÓN-INGLÉS
Murallas	The ancient stone walls built to protect Cartagena from pirates and invasions during colonial times.
Ciudad Amurallada	A music and dance genre originating from the Czech Republic that is very popular in various parts of Latin America, especially in Nicaragua during celebrations.
Getsemaní	A vibrant neighborhood known for its street art, local culture, and lively nightlife.
Castillo de San Felipe	A colonial fortress built by the Spanish to defend the city from attacks.
Palenque	The first free town of enslaved Africans in the Americas, near Cartagena, with strong African heritage.
Cultura Afrocolombiana	Afro-Colombian culture, with influences from African traditions, music, and dance.
Cumbia	A traditional Colombian music and dance genre with African, Indigenous, and Spanish roots.
Tambor Alegre	A traditional hand drum used in coastal Colombian music.
Arepa de huevo	A traditional fried corn cake stuffed with egg, typical of the Colombian coast.
Coco loco	A Caribbean cocktail made with coconut water, rum, and condensed milk, served in a coconut.
Palenquera	The brightly dressed women who sell fruit and sweets, symbol of Cartagena's culture.
"A la orden"	A friendly local expression meaning "At your service!" or "How can I help you?"
Alegría	Joy — a word that describes the spirit and warmth of Cartagena's people.
